Women and Juniors Courses

Defense 101 – Firearms and Self Defense

4 Hours

This is a class for ***WOMEN ONLY***, *includes lunch* and is a must for any woman that wants to better understand her self defense options. The students will be introduced to handguns, rifles and shotguns with a focus on safe handling and storage of firearms for self defense. In addition, basic self defense concepts involving everyday objects, flashlights, pepper spray, etc... will be discussed and ***demonstrated***. Each student will get to shoot multiple firearms as part of this class and there will be ample time allotted for *Questions & Answers*, so students can get the answers they need. ***A female competitive shooter will be helping instruct this class.***

*The following are **NOT REQUIRED**, but helpful to bring to class if available:*

Handgun, ear and eye protection, 100 rounds of ammunition, appropriate clothing (we'll be shooting outside on gravel), and a portable chair.

Boy Scouts 101 - Troop day at the range

4 Hours

This includes 3 hours of classroom time that emphasizes safety while gauging the interests and attitudes of the scouts. Scouts will get to shoot air rifles, rimfire rifles, and shotguns on the range. There will be ample time allotted for Questions & Answers, so scouts can learn more about their area of interest.

Equipment Requirements / Prerequisites:

Eye and ear protection for all scouts and guardians.

Handgun Courses

CCW-MO – Missouri Concealed Carry

8 Hours

This is an all day class that meets the training requirements to obtain a Missouri CCW permit. Does not include Missouri's fees for the permit or processing.

Requirements / Prerequisites: *Must be at least 21 years of age and a Missouri resident.*

Handgun 101 – Advanced CCW Skills

6 Hours

This class is designed for ANYONE that wants to enhance their general handgun skills. According to the FBI, **80% of shootings occur in low or reduced light**. Therefore low and reduced light equipment and tactics are one of the primary focuses of this course, but we also spend a fair amount of time on marksmanship and handgun retention techniques. Students will also be introduced to the “Personal Security Plan” (PSP) concept and have their current defense methods evaluated. Students will leave this class feeling more comfortable with their handgun as part of a PSP.

Equipment Requirements / Prerequisites:

A basic familiarity with handguns OR CCW Holder. Safe and serviceable handgun, 2 magazines or 3 speed loaders, eye and ear protection, belt, holster, 2 magazine pouches or speed loader holders, 200 rounds of ammunition.

Handgun 201 - Introduction to Competitive Handgun

6 Hours

(3 Hours Classroom + Match)

\$15 match fee included in tuition.

This class is perfect for anyone curious about handgun competitions. This class will focus on safety, competitive equipment, stance, grip, draw, and reload. Students get to shoot a USPSA, IDPA or steel plate match under the instructor's supervision as part of the class. Students will leave this class feeling comfortable participating in local handgun competitions.

Equipment Requirements / Prerequisites:

Handgun 101 OR Gun Safety 101 graduate. Safe and serviceable handgun, 2 magazines(5 preferred) or 3 speed loaders(5 preferred) for revolvers, eye and ear protection, belt, holster, 2 magazine pouches or speed loader holders, 300 rounds of ammunition.

Handgun Courses Continued

Handgun 301 – Advanced Competitive Handgun – Session I 6 Hours

The classroom portion of this class will focus on understanding USPSA & IDPA rules and scoring as they relate to the competitor. The range portion of the class is designed to improve the students speed and accuracy while introducing the basics of shooting on the move. Students leave this class with live and dry fire drills for practice.

Equipment Requirements / Prerequisites:

*USPSA classification OR IDPA classification OR Handgun 201 graduate. Safe and serviceable handgun , 5 **magazines or speed loaders**, eye and ear protection, belt, holster, 2 magazine pouches or speed loader holders, 400 rounds of ammunition.*

Handgun 401 - Advanced Competitive Handgun– Session II 6 Hours

The classroom portion of this class will focus on learning how to evaluate USPSA & IDPA stages from a competitor's viewpoint and introduce the mental aspects of competitive shooting. Students will leave with advanced training drills and an understanding of how to get the most out of practice sessions with limited time and/or ammunition.

Equipment Requirements / Prerequisites:

*USPSA classification OR IDPA classification OR Handgun 301 graduate. Safe and serviceable semi-auto or revolver, **8 magazines or speed loaders**, eye and ear protection, belt, holster, 2 magazine pouches or speed loader holders, 600 rounds of ammunition.*

Rifle Courses

Rifle 201 – Mastering the AR-15

8 Hours

This class is a **MUST** for anyone that owns an AR-15. You'll learn manipulation, marksmanship, proper use of a sling, ammo & equipment selection, field stripping, transitioning to a pistol, proper shooting positions (standing, kneeling, sitting, and prone), 223 ballistics, how to use various sighting systems, and how to quickly acquire the best position for a good hit. You'll also learn how to get first round hits up to 300 yards. We will cover how to shoot on the move and how to safely move quickly with your carbine when not engaging targets. This is the PERFECT class for anyone interested in entering the world of 3-gun competitions.

Equipment Requirements / Prerequisites:

Basic rifle skills, an AR-15 rifle, eye and ear protection, and 200 rounds of ammunition.

Optional Equipment(For practicing transitions to handgun):

Safe and serviceable handgun, 1 magazine or speed loader, belt, holster, 50 rounds of handgun ammunition.

Rifle 301 – Advanced Rifle Shooting (Great for Hunters)

6 Hours

This course is for people who want a comprehensive course in the essential elements of rifle shooting, and is especially useful for hunters. We have already helped hunters from 12 to 74 that wanted to enhance their rifle skills. This class will strengthen your marksmanship where it really counts -- in the field. The class will provide a thorough understanding of ballistics at ranges from 25 to 300 yards, and by the end of your course, if you can see it; you'll probably be able to hit it. We will determine the ***optimal sight-in yardage for YOUR rifle and YOUR goals*** and actually sight it in as part of the class. This class is about learning your rifle and its capabilities.

Equipment Requirements / Prerequisites:

Basic rifle skills, a rifle capable of ranges to 300 yards, eye and ear protection, 1 box of practice ammo, 1 box of the hunting ammo to be used in the field.

Rifle Courses Continued

Rifle 401 – Practical Long Range Shooting I

8 Hours

This class is for a person with a scoped rifle capable of 1 MOA* accuracy that has never shot beyond 200 yards. We will start the first day in the classroom covering ballistics, optical adjustments, using a Mil-Dot reticle, and much more. The more you understand the rifle and ammunition you are using, the more effective you will be.

Some of the topics covered in this course include:

- ❖ Advanced ballistics
- ❖ MOA adjustments
- ❖ Mil-Dot
- ❖ Sighting in your rifle at 200 yards

This class is a real eye opener for anyone interested in Long Range Shooting!

Equipment Requirements / Prerequisites:

Basic rifle skills, a manually operated rifle capable of 1 MOA accuracy, eye and ear protection, and 20 rounds of MATCH GRADE ammunition.

** 1MOA is Minute of Angle or approximately 1 inch at 100 Yards.*

Rifle 402 – Practical Long Range Shooting II

8 Hours

The second day is spent on the range and we, put into practice the information covered in the classroom. The learning really begins on the range where the student will shoot at 100 yards, 200 yards, 300 yards and 500 meters under time pressure.

Some of the topics covered in this course include:

- ❖ Marksmanship
- ❖ Optical adjustments
- ❖ Known distance shooting
- ❖ Unknown distance shooting

Equipment Requirements / Prerequisites:

Rifle 401 graduate OR passing written & shooting test, eye and ear protection, and 60 rounds of MATCH GRADE ammunition.

Private Instruction

Private 801 – Private Instruction

3 Hour Min.

Private Instruction is focused on your individual goals and the date of the class is chosen to work with **your schedule**. Private instruction is available in many different areas including:

- 1) Self Defense
- 2) Handgun
- 3) Rifle
- 4) Shotgun

Whether you want to become more proficient with you carry gun, become an IDPA Master, or just test the limits of your hunting rifle we can help you reach your goals.

Please note that we **HIGHLY RECOMMEND** enrolling in Private Instruction with a **FRIEND**. Some of the benefits of taking this instruction with a friend are:

- 1) Sharing the per hour cost of instruction
- 2) Having time to reload while your friend is shooting
